Policy Title: Meetings of the Board and Order of Regular Board Meetings

Code Number: 204.10

Meetings of the Board are conducted for the purpose of carrying on the business of the schools. The Board may establish policies and rules for its own government and determine procedures that will be followed during Board meetings. The Board shall govern itself and conduct business according to Robert's Rules of Order.

The majority of the full membership of the Board constitutes a quorum and must be present for the transaction of business. An affirmative majority vote of those present and voting shall be necessary to pass any motion or take any action.
