Policy Title: Interviews By Or On Behalf of Educational Agencies

Code Number: 502.6

Written consent shall not be required for interviews of students by district-approved organizations conducting studies for, or on behalf of, educational agencies or institutions for the purpose of developing, validating, or administering predictive tests, administering student aid programs, or improving instruction, or as part of an audit or other evaluation necessary for the receipt of funds pursuant to the No Child Left Behind Act or any other Federally or State supported education programs, if such studies are conducted in such a manner as will not permit the personal identification of students and/or their parents by persons other than representatives of such organizations and when such information will be destroyed after it is no longer needed for the purpose for which such interviews or studies are conducted.

Written consent shall also not be required for student interviews and release of information obtained from such interviews, when interviews are performed as part of an audit, peer review process, or other evaluation necessary for the receipt of funds pursuant to the No Child Left Behind Act.
