## EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

### *Series 600*

**Policy Title:** Career Education

**Code Number:** 604.4

Career education for all students, grades pre-kindergarten through twelve, is an important component of the total educational program. Career education shall include, but not be limited to, career awareness and exploration; strong academic skills with emphasis in written and oral communication, mathematics, and science; work-site experiences including job shadowing and internships, workplace values and skills such as self-management, teamwork, and problem solving and experiences in personal decision-making.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to assist certified personnel in finding ways to provide career education across the curriculum. The Board, in its review of curriculum, shall review the integration of career education with other instructional programs. Career education shall be infused into each curricular area. New curriculum will be reviewed to insure the integration of career education into all instructional programs.
