## **AUXILIARY SERVICES**

### ***Series 700***

**Policy Title:       School Food Program**

**Code Number:     706.1**

In order to provide maximum learning, a nutritious food service program will be provided that accords with all state and federal requirements. Students may bring their own lunches to school.

The school food program is operated on a nonprofit basis. The board will set, and periodically review, the prices for school lunches (breakfast), and school milk programs. It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to make a recommendation regarding the prices of school lunch (breakfast) and milk.

It shall be the responsibility of the school food authority/determining official to determine if a student qualifies for free or reduced cost school food services. Students whom the principal believes are improperly nourished will not be denied the school food program services simply because paperwork has not been completed. Food Service needs a completed application on file in order for a student to participate in the school food program.
