Policy Title: Student Transportation for Extracurricular Activities

Code Number: 709.3

Responsibility for transporting students to extracurricular activities is that of the student and his/her parent(s) or guardian(s). The Board, at its discretion, may provide District transportation for extracurricular activities including, but not limited to, transporting student participants and other students to and from extracurricular events.

Students who are provided transportation in District vehicles for extracurricular events shall ride both to and from the event in the school vehicle unless arrangements have been made with the building principal or his/her designee prior to the event. A student's parent may personally appear and request to transport the student home from a school-sponsored event in which the student traveled to the event on a District transportation vehicle.

Nothing contained in this policy by way of provision of District transportation shall be precedential from year to year. It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to make a recommendation to the Board annually as to whether the District shall provide the transportation authorized in this policy. In making the recommendation to the Board, the Superintendent shall consider the financial condition of the District, the number of students who would qualify for such transportation, and other factors the Board or Superintendent deem relevant.
