The individual school names are not announced. Please make arrangements for your children, and make sure that they know what to do if school is dismissed early. You must have a plan so that your children will be in a safe place. **ONLY ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS** are dismissed due to heat, as the middle and high schools have air conditioning.

If you have any **changes in your address or phone number**, it is very important to let us know right away. If you know of any new families in the area who may not have registered their children, please call the ESL Office as soon as possible to make an appointment before school begins.
