**Hunt Elementary – Potential Enrollment and Boundaries:** Brian Burnight presented and explained the data for enrollment, student population, and boundaries for Hunt, Leeds, Irving, and the future Bryant (attached). After detailed discussion of this information and the demographer's report, Charlie Lange made a motion to prepare a recommendation to the School Board for the November 27 Board Meeting to design the Hunt Elementary replacement for 450 students (2 story) instead of 575 students (3 story) as suggested in the April 3, 2017, Board Work Session. Paul Stensland seconded. It was approved unanimously.
