Hunt Elementary Project Updates: Bryan Wells provided an update on Bid Packages 1 and 2 as well as an upcoming City reconstruction project on Pierce St that abuts the Hunt project. Brian Fahrendholz provided an update on the asbestos abatement and necessary home demolitions. Matt Basye provided a brief update on the beginning stages of the actual building design. There was discussion regarding a Century Link underground utility relocation issue on 20th St. Bryan and Brian will continue working with Century Link on the most reasonable solution and ask for review by the Committee before requesting School Board approval.

ESC Career Academy Tour: A tour was provided of the ESC Career Academy project. Matt Basye and Brian Fahrendholz explained the details of the construction and floor plan. Dr. Gausman provided a detailed explanation of the educational programs being offered next school year and plans for Phases 2 and 3 of the project. The Committee recommended the District publicize the success of this project and the Career Academy programs as it is an impressive asset to the community.
