Kindergarten and Third Grade Students

According to Iowa law, all children enrolled in grades K and 3 are required to have evidence of a vision screening no earlier than one year prior to enrollment or six months after. Vision screening forms are available through the school nurse or your eye care professional.

Kindergarten Registration - Kindergarten Registration is April 10 for children who will attend Kindergarten next school year. Children must be 5 years of age by September 15 to be able to attend next year.
